

STOP HIDDEN GAS TAXES PRIVACY POLICY

Here at *Stop Hidden Gas Taxes* (the “Coalition”), we understand and respect your concerns about the use of your personal information. We believe that you should know what information about you we collect, as well as how that information is used, maintained, and, in some cases, shared. The following sets forth our privacy practices and policies.

We will collect information about you when you register on our website to join the Coalition, when you transmit information to us via our website or by email, and when you otherwise use this website. By doing any of the foregoing, you assent to this privacy policy. If you do not agree with the terms of this policy, please do not engage in any of these activities.

INFORMATION COLLECTED ABOUT YOU AND OUR USE OF SUCH INFORMATION

The following describes the types of personal and other information we may collect about you, and how we use and maintain that information:

Contact Information

We collect your contact information when you register on our website to join the Coalition, when you send a letter from our website, when you sign up to receive email updates on pending legislation and when you transmit such information to us via our website, by email, or otherwise. Specifically, we collect and store in a database your name, mailing address, and email address, and may also collect and store your phone number.

We use this information to communicate with you about the Coalition, and issues or activities of a similar nature which may be of interest to you. We also use this information to respond to any inquiries you may submit to us. In addition, we may use this information to send you periodic publications associated with the Coalition or issues of interest outside the activities of the Coalition, unless you inform us that you opt out from receiving such communications via email. We also use your contact information to operate this website.

Website Information

Our website employs browser cookies to store users’ preferences and record session information. “Cookies” are bits of information that are stored by your browser on your hard drive. This technology allows you to save your password, if applicable, so you don’t have to re-enter it each time you visit our site, and remembers you when you take action on our site. You can turn off the “cookie” function through most standard browsers.

In addition, when you visit our website our system automatically collects your IP address and the type of browser that you use. When you browse our website, our systems log the Coalition web pages that you visit.

The Coalition may track information on which website pages are being visited and used so we can make decisions about the design and usage of our site.

Other Information

We may retain any data you provide to us in an email or other inquiry, for the purpose of tracking the types of questions or input that we receive.

Security

Whenever the Coalition handles information that you enter on our site, regardless of where this occurs, we take steps to ensure that your information is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy. Unfortunately, no data transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. As a result, while we strive to protect your personal information, the Coalition cannot ensure or warrant the security of any information you transmit to us, and

you do so at your own risk. Once we receive your transmission, we make our best effort to ensure its security on our systems.

Our site has security measures in place to protect against the alteration of the information under our control.

WHEN YOUR INFORMATION WILL BE SHARED OR DISCLOSED

We may provide your name, mailing address, email address and other information you provide to members of the Coalition and agents, contractors and other representatives of the Coalition.

We will comply with any subpoenas, court orders or other legal processes for any of the information about you in our possession, and we may use such information to establish or exercise our legal rights, or to defend against legal claims.

We may provide aggregate information, such as the number of users who visit this site, to other parties.

In addition, information about you in our possession may be disclosed as part of any fundamental change to members of the Coalition and agents, contractors or other representatives of the Coalition.

CHILDREN'S PRIVACY

Although our website may be accessed by children under the age of 13, we will not knowingly collect or use any personal information from such children. If we become aware that we have collected any personal information from children under 13, we will promptly delete such information from our databases.

OTHER WEBSITES

For your convenience, this website may contain links to other websites. This privacy policy does not apply to these linked websites. Each website should be checked for its own privacy policy. Any information you share with such a website is subject to its policies and practices and is independent of the Coalition

CHANGES TO THIS POLICY

The Coalition may from time to time update this privacy policy. Whenever a change to this policy is significant, we will place a prominent notice on this website.

GOVERNING LAW

By choosing to visit this website or otherwise provide information to the Coalition, you agree that any dispute over privacy or the terms contained in this privacy policy will be governed by the law of the State of California. You also agree to arbitrate such disputes and to abide by any limitation on damages contained in our Terms of Use or other agreement we have with you.
